PROPOSED ROUTES

- 90 km over three days from base camp @ Nuweberg Boland Mountains – Hotentots Holland Nature Reserve – 11km out of Grabouw
- **Day 1**: 21 km up to *Landroskop* via the Stokoe's pass, then 12 km back to base camp via the sphinx route.
- Day 2: 16 km to *Boesmankloof* via the Pofaddernek route, 14 km back to base camp, via the orchard route and Horrible Hill.
- **Day 3**: 14 km to *Mara farm*, via Horrible Hill and Droster's nek and 8 km back to base camp via
